Introduction

This guide provides details about every named location on the map for Intercontinental.

Apart from a few notable impassible regions (detailed in the next section), these details will be provided for each location:

- Whether the location should be considered water, coastal, or inland.
 - Water locations can only be occupied by fleets. Fleets may only perform convoy orders when occupying water.
 - Inland locations can only be occupied by armies.
 - Coastal locations can be occupied by either unit type.
- Whether the location is a Supply Center.
 - Whether it is a Home SC, and for what power and color.
 - Whether it is a Minor Neutral.
 - Whether it is an Affiliate, and for what color.
 - The starting unit type for the location.
- For coastal locations, whether the region has a split coastline, and how those are delineated (north/south or east/west).
- Adjacent locations:
 - For fleets, listed by coastline when applicable.
 - For armies.
- Notable game-related features of the region, particularly canal-like relationships.

Where applicable, island locations will also note when they have no adjacency for armies but can still be occupied by armies (assumedly brought there via convoy).

If you come across any errors in this document, particularly information missing or that appears to disagree with the published game maps, please do

I have tried to be thorough and careful here, but with so *many* different locations, the likelihood of some errors slipping by me is high. If this index, the published maps, and/or the node charts disagree and cause a dispute in an ongoing game, consult with your GM and use your best judgment.

Impassible

Unnamed, unlabeled locations on the map (like the islands of Cyprus and Corsica) should all be treated as impassible; they are not used for game purposes.

The following three impassible locations are notable interruptions of the map topology.

Antarctica

Impassible southernmost continent and polar ice cap. Map may show it growing and shrinking based on the season of the year, but this has no effect on the overall map topology.

Arctic Ice

Impassible northern polar ice cap in the Arctic Ocean. Map may show it growing and shrinking based on the season of the year, but this has no effect on the overall map topology. For example, the Arctic Ice can grow to touch the island of Novaya Zemlya, but this does not change the adjacency between the nearby Kara Sea and Barents Sea.

Lake Erie

Impassible. One of the five Great Lakes in eastern North America, located between the USA and Canada. Not explicitly labeled on the map.

Notable because, unlike other unlabeled lakes, it interrupts the topology of the surrounding regions. Lake Erie prevents direct travel between Ottawa and New York City as well as between Old Northwest and Upstate.

Before the Suez Canal opens in 1870, Alexandria shares a coastline with Suez (north coast). After it opens, Alexandria shares a coast with Suez in general. Alexandria has an inland border with Cairo but never shares a coastline with Cairo.

The player controlling the Dutch East Indies treats Amsterdam as their Affiliate. Historically, the Netherlands was the colonial ruler of the Dutch East Indies; for gameplay purposes this relationship is inverted.
